



The Role Of The Sub-District Government in Overcoming Social Order Disturbances in Banyuputih Sub-District, Situbondo Regency

Abstract. *This study aims to describe and analyze: The Role of the District Government in Overcoming Social Order Disturbances, the Obstacles Faced by the District Government in Overcoming Social Order Disturbances and the Solutions Carried Out in Overcoming Obstacles. This research is a qualitative research with a level of descriptive analysis, with data collection techniques using interviews, observations, and documentation. Data analysis techniques Interactive data analysis. The results of the study show that the Village Government Strategy in an Effort to Improve Village Development in Mahakam Regency is carried out with several steps, namely development planning is carried out based on the village development plan musaywarah from the lowest scope, namely RT/RW. The implementation of development is carried out based on the Development Budget Plan, namely what priorities will be implemented, which are locally managed by village self-management, village cooperation with third parties. The process of monitoring and evaluation of development is carried out at the village and sub-district levels assisted by community institutions that check the list of activities listed in the Development Work Plan document stipulated in the Village Budget. The development supervision process is carried out through community institutions and community leaders. The obstacles faced in the development of villages in Mahakam Regency include the lack of achieving the desired development, this is due to the difficulty of obtaining funds. Efforts made include proposing a village Musrenbang next year, making a medium-term long-term development plan for a term of 5 years and including RKA and RKP*

Abstrak. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mendeskripsikan dan menganalisis: Peran Pemerintah Kabupaten dalam Mengatasi Gangguan Ketertiban Sosial, Kendala-kendala yang Dihadapi Pemerintah Kabupaten dalam Mengatasi Gangguan Ketertiban Sosial dan Solusi yang Dilakukan dalam Mengatasi Kendala tersebut. Penelitian ini merupakan penelitian kualitatif dengan tingkat analisis deskriptif, dengan teknik pengumpulan data menggunakan wawancara, observasi, dan dokumentasi. Teknik analisis data Analisis data interaktif. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa Strategi Pemerintahan Desa dalam Upaya Peningkatan Pembangunan Desa di Kabupaten Mahakam dilaksanakan dengan beberapa langkah yaitu perencanaan pembangunan dilakukan berdasarkan musaywarah rencana pembangunan desa dari lingkup paling bawah yaitu RT/RW . Pelaksanaan pembangunan dilakukan berdasarkan Rencana Anggaran Pembangunan yaitu prioritas apa yang akan dilaksanakan, yang dikelola secara lokal dengan swakelola desa, kerjasama desa dengan pihak ketiga. Proses pemantauan dan evaluasi pembangunan dilakukan di tingkat desa dan kelurahan dibantu oleh lembaga masyarakat yang memeriksa daftar kegiatan yang tercantum dalam dokumen Rencana Kerja Pembangunan yang ditetapkan dalam APBD. Proses pengawasan pembangunan dilakukan melalui lembaga masyarakat dan tokoh masyarakat. Kendala yang dihadapi dalam pembangunan desa di Kabupaten Mahakam antara lain belum tercapainya pembangunan yang diinginkan, hal ini disebabkan sulitnya memperoleh dana. Upaya yang dilakukan antara lain mengusulkan Musrenbang desa pada tahun depan, membuat rencana pembangunan jangka menengah jangka panjang untuk jangka waktu 5 tahun dan memuat RKA dan RKP.

1. INTRODUCTION

The government is basically formed to serve the community, especially to meet its basic needs. Public safety and order are a basic need that is always expected by the community in carrying out daily activities. The existence of a sense of security and order in community life will be able to improve the level of community welfare, on the other hand, if the community is

faced with unsafe conditions, it will disrupt the order of community life which in turn will disrupt the fulfillment of living standards (Habibi, 2018).

The government, both at the central and regional levels, has an obligation to maintain peace and order in its society. The mandate of Law Number 23 of 2014 in Article 65 paragraph (1) emphasizes that each Regional Head has a duty in maintaining peace and order in his community. To achieve the goals of the State, of course, it is necessary to cooperate between government agencies, in this case the Executive, Legislative and Judiciary to carry out all tasks to fulfill and protect the interests of the Indonesian nation by participating starting from the Central Government, Regional Government, District Government and Village Government.

The sub-district government is led by a sub-district head appointed by the Regent based on the mandate of Law Number 23 of 2014 and Government Regulation Number 17 of 2018, also plays the role of regional head even though in its implementation its authority is limited. However, in government, Law Number 23 of 2014 and Government Regulation Number 17 of 2018, the Sub-district Head should be obliged to carry out the duties of the General Government in the District area, especially the attributive duties in the field of government coordination for all government agencies in the District area in the implementation of peace and order, enforcement of laws and regulations, fostering the implementation of village and/or sub-district government, as well as the implementation of other government duties that have not been carried out by the village/sub-district government and/or other government agencies in the sub-district area.

Explanation of Presidential Regulation Number 17 of 2018 concerning sub-districts, one of the duties and functions of sub-districts, namely in article 10, states that sub-districts carry out peace and public order in the sub-district area, as coordinators and coordinate in the implementation of activities. More details in article 10 paragraph (1) letter c of Government Regulation number 17 of 2018 concerning sub-districts that the duties of the sub-district head in coordinating efforts to implement peace and public order as referred to are: 1. Synergy with the National Police of the Republic of Indonesia, the Indonesian National Army and vertical courts in the sub-district area. 2. Harmonization of relations with religious leaders and community leaders and 3. Report on the implementation of peace and order development to the regent/mayor.

Peace and order is a dynamic state that is expected by the community in carrying out daily activities. Basically, the community really wants a feeling and an environment that is safe from all forms of actions, actions and intimidation that lead to and cause things that will damage the order of community life, both done by people in the environment and from outside the area.

Maintaining peace and order and reconciling community disputes in the sub-district, all of this is the obligation of the sub-district government, especially the sub-district head in carrying out its duties. This is a manifestation in fostering people's lives so that they can live more safely, orderly, peaceful and peaceful.

Conflict in the region is a problem that always occurs during the period of government in Indonesia. Seeing the symptoms of conflict that may start from small problems, if left unchecked, it can burn the harmony of community life that has been built for a long time. Furthermore, it can be a threat to the integration of the nation. Government apparatus must be smart in soaking up conflicts in various regions. The source of conflict in the region can be triggered by various conditions exaggerated by certain groups for the interests and needs of their groups. The accumulation of claims of interests between individuals and community groups in conflict areas that are not able to be resolved properly, resulting in the expansion of the integrity of the community from issues that were previously small to big issues that spread and destroyed the joints of society (Kanoneng, et al 2018)

Based on the results of the author's observations in the field, there are still problems that occur in Banyuputih District regarding peace and social order. In accordance with the mandate of laws and government regulations regarding the duties of local governments, especially the Regency/City Government, whose spearhead is the sub-district, the sub-district head and its apparatus have not carried out optimally. The following is explained some of the incidents of peace and public order that occurred during the period from 2021 to 2024, including: Cockfighting gambling is still high. Cockfighting activities must always be carried out if there is a traditional celebration because it has been considered a tradition by the community. As a result of the community's assumptions mentioned earlier, it results in less effective preventive measures, especially not being given a delegation of duties. Based on the mandate of laws and other regulations. The still rampant fights between residents are caused by offense to each other. The offense is caused by, among others, liquor, disputes related to property, land, inheritance; lack of Kamling Posts in each village so that night patrols are not carried out, because of which theft is still rampant, which is characterized by people often reporting the loss of livestock and the loss of motor vehicles.

Several studies have been conducted related to the role of the sub-district government in the implementation of public order conducted by Kanoneng et al (2018), which stated that some places that are subscription to conflicts do not receive more attention at all to see the causal factors or the environment that builds conflicts in these places. Singkil District, in addition to that, coordination between agencies at the city level that take care of fights between

groups is still very tenuous. The police are still the center of solving problems that are still personal. Sociological solutions that are embedded in the form of urban community empowerment policies should have been considered as best as possible. The research of Gahansa et al (2018) shows that the village government and community leaders in the village work together to provide guidance to every level of society about the need for security and order in community life, then efforts to provide human resources and security apparatus in the village, have been carried out by lifting hansip due to the shortage of hansip personnel in every neighborhood in Lewet village and providing training for each hansip.

The role of the sub-district government in carrying out its duties is felt to need to be improved again so that peace and social order in the sub-district and in the sub-districts are well maintained and the problems that have been resolved are not repeated even if a similar incident occurs, the government can respond quickly and well. Based on the phenomenon of peace and order that has been described above, this study aims to describe and analyze the Role of the Banyuputih District Government in Overcoming Social Order Disturbances, describe and analyze the obstacles faced by the Banyuputih District Government in Overcoming Social Order Disturbances and what solutions have been carried out in overcoming the obstacles faced, and finally determine the model the concept of the government's role in overcoming social order disturbances in Banyuputih District, Situbondo Regency.

2. THEORETICAL FRAMEWORK

The function of the government, in addition to providing the widest possible space for the benefit of all the people, also has the task of meeting all the needs of the community by carrying out development, coaching, and carrying out empowerment efforts. The role and function of the organization of a government based on an administrative perspective in the administrative system begins with the maturation of the level of power, task authority, specificity, organization management, and control. Based on the perspective of social psychology; The institution of a government is highly correlated with the attitude of human beings as bureaucratic elements that exist at the level of government organization, this is in the form of the attitude of each individual/group, formal or informal, behaving internally and externally in government institutions (Ndraha,1987)

The presence of the existence of a government is an important part of people's lives, in groups and individually. The presence of the government functions to regulate and provide protection for citizens so that they live safely and in an orderly manner. Various problems in

society that continue to develop, will slowly be known and known by the State, this is a problem that must be solved by government agencies (Thoha :2005)

The Government's role in the spotlight is as follows (Sondang, P Siagian:2003)

- a. As a Stabilizer, the government must make a change if there is social turmoil that is predicted to be a threat to the integrity of the State. This role can be in various ways such as: capability, socializing policies, through an educational perspective, as well as a gradual and continuous persuasive perspective.
- b. The role of creating new ideas must be to find new ideas. At the beginning of the condition for the role of the government to be effective, the government must have *high legitimacy*. The three issues that are absolutely the center of serious attention are how to apply a new idea to the bureaucratic system, both in the form of conceptual innovation, innovation in the system, innovation in certain steps and working principles.
- c. The role of the Modernisator in the process of building, each country has the desire to become a strong country, a country that can be independent and considered equal to other countries. This can be achieved if the State has mastery in the field of science, the capability and expertise to manage, the ability to manage existing natural resources to have *high added value*, a reliable national education system to create useful human resources, the basis for a strong and democratic political life, and has a purposeful goal for the future.
- d. The role of a pioneer must have the ability to be a model for all citizens. As a pioneer in the idea of new ideas, positive such as effective work, as a pioneer in creating justice and discipline, as a pioneer in caring for the environment, in a socio-cultural perspective, and as a pioneer willing to sacrifice for the benefit of the nation
- e. The role of the Implementer itself means that when carrying out development policies, the development strategy is a national obligation and is not considered a burden on the government, therapy will be carried out as a form for the safety of the State.

The role of the government apparatus is optimal and deep to build society, therefore the role of the government apparatus referred to by Yusuf (2014) is:

a. The government as a regulator

Pemerintah sebagai regulator artinya bahwa pemerintah sebagai pelaksana dan penggerak masyarakat harus menyiapkan arah untuk menyeimbangkan penyelenggaraan pembangunan, dengan menyiapkan dan menetapkan peraturan bagi masyarakat dalam rangka peningkatan efektifitas untuk tertib dalam pengembangan dan pembangunan. Pemerintah sebagai regulator memberikan acuan dasar yang selanjutnya di pahami oleh

masyarakat umum sebagai bentuk arahan untuk mengatur hal-hal yang menyangkut kegiatan pelaksanaan pemberdayaan masyarakat.

b. Government as a dynamizer

The role of the government as a dynamizer is to arouse community participation if problems arise in the development process to advance and maintain the dynamics of regional development. The government plays a role in providing guidance and direction that is intensive and effective to the community. The role of the government as a dynamizer functions to provide effective and comprehensive guidance and direction to the community regardless of differences or social strata in society.

c. Government as a facilitator

The role of the government as a facilitator is to create conducive conditions for development implementers or to play a role in connecting the interests of the government to the community and vice versa in terms of optimizing regional development activities. As a facilitator, the government must be an agent that is able to create and provide facilities that are in accordance with the needs of the community with safe, comfortable and orderly conditions.

The government, including the Regional Government, has the role and task of providing legal protection to the community to realize community security and order in their area. This role is the embodiment of the mandate of the purpose of establishing the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia. This is expressly stated in the main task of the Government which carries out aspects of security and order as the national goal. This purpose is stated in the Preamble to the 1945 Constitution, Article 43 letter f of Law No. 22 of 1999 and Article 13 paragraph (1) letter c of Law No. 32 of 2004 jo. Article 100 of Law No. 39 of 1999 concerning Human Rights. Based on the considerations mentioned above, this thesis is prepared to find out the functions of local governments, influencing factors, and steps taken by local governments in providing legal protection to the community to create security and order in the region. The research conducted on this issue is normative juridical, namely reviewing and processing research data with a starting point on the normative legal aspects (which are written in legislation) accompanied by theoretical studies supported by empirical facts that occur in the field and contained in court decisions. The results of the study provide an overview of the factual condition of the policy aspects of the implementation of the Central Kalimantan regional government in providing legal protection to the community. This is mainly seen through the elements of 1) Government policies that were not appropriate in the past. 2) The process of fostering and empowering human beings has been less successful in the past. 3)

Cultural Clash. 4) A sense of injustice. 5) Poverty 6) Unconducive security. 7) Uncertainty in law enforcement.

Article 10 paragraph (1) letter c of Government Regulation number 17 of 2018 concerning sub-districts that the duties of the sub-district head in coordinating efforts to implement peace and public order as referred to, include: a. Synergy with the National Police of the Republic of Indonesia, the Indonesian National Army and vertical stations in the sub-district area; b. Harmonization of relations with religious leaders and community leaders and; c. Report the implementation of peace and order development to the regent/mayor.

The government, both at the central and regional levels, has an obligation to maintain peace and order in its society. The mandate of Law Number 23 of 2014 in Article 65 paragraph (1) emphasizes that each Regional Head has a duty in maintaining peace and order in his community. One of the government's obligations daerah yaitu melakukan pemeliharaan ketentraman dan ketertiban soial. Masyarakat.

3. RESEARCH METHOD

Based on the goal to be achieved in the research, which is to be able to describe and analyze the results of the research in a complete and in-depth manner, the type of research used is qualitative research. Data collection techniques in this study include Interviews, Observations, Documentation and Focus Group Discussion (FGD). The informants in the study included authorized officials consisting of the Sub-district Head, Head of the Government Section, Head of the Peace and Order Section, Head of Sub-Head in Banyuputih District, Situbondo Regency. The data analysis technique in the study using interactive model analysis was developed by Miles et al., (2014) with three procedures, namely data condensation, data display, and conclusion drawing.

4. RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

The Role of the District Government as a Regulator in Overcoming Social Order Disturbances

The role of the Government as a regulator is to prepare directions to balance the implementation of development through the issuance of regulations. As a regulator, the government provides a basic reference to the community as an instrument to regulate security and security. As a regulator, the government issues regulations or laws Number 23 of 2014 concerning Regional Government that every head of state has a duty in maintaining public peace and order. Basically, local governments have the responsibility for the welfare of the

community and meet the basic needs of the community, such as education, health, people's purchasing power, public facilities and so on. However, as the times develop, there are many security disturbances in various places, so that security becomes one of the categories of basic needs of the community that is the responsibility of the local government. The findings of the study show that the sub-district government as a regulator prepares a direction to balance the implementation of development (issuing regulations in the context of the effectiveness and orderliness of development administration). The sub-district government conducts Socialization Activities that are carried out when a form of decision is issued in the form of legal regulations that are regulated and intersect with public security and order. Actions to counter social order and security are clearly related to it, an example of one of the socialization of laws held by the KESBANG kanto is the socialization of the Law on the procedure for expressing opinions in front of the public. Regarding the technical guidance on conflict resolution related to social order disturbances by the Sub-district Head, from the exposure of several conditions of the one-day forum was only supportive of the community leaders who were involved were given the opportunity to issue opinions on the resolution of social order disturbances. As a regulator, the local government issued Regional Regulation of Situbondo Regency Number 7 of 2018 concerning Public Order and Public Order. Public Order and Public Order is a dynamic situation that allows the Regional Government and the community to carry out activities in a peaceful, orderly, and orderly manner. PERDA Number 7 of 2018 concerning Public Order and Public Order, was made to make it easier for the community to carry out daily activities with the norms contained in the laws and regulations.

The Role of the District Government as an Implementer in Overcoming Social Order Disturbances

The implementer is interpreted as an institution responsible for development activities nationally, the program is not a burden, considering that there are things that need to be considered such as the safety of the state, the existence of capital constraints, the existence of capabilities that are still lacking, because the program does not receive a response from the community and constitutionally it is the main task of the government, if the government in one case is not able to implement, Therefore, these activities should not be given to the private sector, the government must continue to carry out it itself. As an implementing party, the government must predict various factors that can affect national development. Having the ability to control obstacles that are obstacles to the implementation of development nationally so that the effect can be minimized, and the government must also know various factors as

drivers of national development (Sondang, P Siagian: 2003). The government as the implementer of Kamtibmas Development is to foster the community in preventing, warding off, and overcoming all forms of crime that can disturb the community.

The findings of the study show that as the Executor of the Banyuputih District Government, Situbondo District, together with several agencies such as the Pamong Praja Police Unit, the Police and the Koramil carry out Routine Patrols to suppress crime to maintain public order and security. The joint officers also carried out special operations that were carried out on certain days. The sub-district government also takes action against individuals or groups who commit illegal acts and disrupt public security and order. In addition to conducting direct operations or making publicity appeals to the community and the police also coordinate with the wider community, RT/RW chairmen or community leaders who are considered as elders in their respective areas. The meaning of mutual coordination is that the District and Agencies of course often coordinate with the community about disturbances in security and social order of the community, if you see firsthand the crimes committed, please report directly to the police station so that the police immediately follow up on the crimes that occur.

The Role of the District Government as a Stabilizer in Overcoming Social Order Disturbances

Stabilizer can be interpreted as an understanding or awareness of what the law itself is and what it should be. By increasing the Stabilizer in society, of course, the community will know between what should be done and what should not be done. Public awareness of what the law means that people are aware that the law is the protection of the interests of others so that there is no fear in carrying out daily activities.

Security and order problems are not only the responsibility of the security forces, but the local community also has a role in maintaining security and order in their area. Therefore, the local government also feels the need to increase public awareness of security and order concerns so that people are not easily provoked and do not participate in taking part or even joining groups that provoke conflicts.

The findings of the study show that as a stabilizer, the Banyuputih sub-district government, Situbondo Regency coordinates and cooperates with related agencies through BHABINKAMTIBNAS. Bhabinkamtibmas are National Police officers whose services are at the village to sub-district levels who are tasked with carrying out Pre-emptive functions by partnering with the community. The preemptive function is all efforts and activities of the National Police in fostering the community to increase community participation, as well as

increasing awareness of laws and regulations in everyone in the community both at the village and sub-district levels so that every member of the community can play an active role in every activity that can build their village for the better. The role of this Stabilizer is carried out by carrying out activities to visit residents' homes, carrying out patrol activities. Conducting socialization activities about social, security order that is developing today.

The Role of the District Government as a Pioneer in Overcoming Social Order Disturbances

As a government apparatus that has high authority, the village government must be able to protect the community, set a good example, have high dedication (loyalty), and be able to give a good appearance to the community so that the government can be appreciated and respected and respected by the community. The pioneer is that the District Government must first implement innovation in the government itself, explicitly the view is also that the government must play its role as a pioneer in various aspects of national security. In other words, as a pioneer must be a role model for the community

In the role, first to maintain security and order in Banyuputih District, the Regency focuses on first seeking information from the potential and indications of the slightest possibility of security disturbances. This must be anticipated by the government with full sensitivity and readiness. Various forms of efforts from the government in seeking information that can cause disturbances of order and security by making early detection efforts as government capital or supporting factors in the implementation of strategies to maintain security and order. The Regional Intelligence Community plays a very important role in the early approach to issues regarding movements that are considered suspicious and to immediately follow the soft power strategy so that the thoughts of security and order disturbances spread to the community and the community can think openly about everything.

The Regional Intelligence Community is in the first step to find out the issues and actions that occur in the community that have the potential to disrupt security and order in Banyuputih District, Situbondo Regency. To anticipate and reduce friction, the Regional Intelligence Community always holds coordination meetings to detect early issues that occur during the community, which can disrupt regional security stability.

Factors Hindering the Role of the Banyuputih District Government in Overcoming Social Order Disturbances in Banyuputih District, Situbondo Regency.

Maintaining peace and social order is one of the obligations of the Banyuputih Observation Government of Situbondo Regency in accordance with PERDA Number 7 of 2018 concerning Public Order and Public Order. In maintaining peace and social order, the Banyuputih sub-district government has obstacles that cause disturbances of peace and order.

People Who Don't Understand the Law

The public's understanding of this law should be very important in the implementation of an orderly and peaceful life. Even in the settlement of a dispute, there is a law and there is a flow of the process of resolving the problem. However, the understanding of the people of Banyuputih District, Situbondo Regency towards this law is still lacking. Research findings from informants show that the problem of disturbing peace and order occurs because the community does not know the law. So that there is a disturbance of peace and order which should not happen if the public knows about laws and regulations, both central government regulations and local government regulations.

Limited Facilities and Infrastructure

In maintaining peace and order in Banyuputih District, Situbondo Regency does not always run smoothly. There are several obstacles that hinder the implementation of the sub-district government in maintaining peace and order. The lack of facilities and infrastructure greatly affects the alertness and responsiveness of the village government in maintaining peace and order.

Limited number of personnel

One of the reasons that is often present in the implementation of the main duties and functions of the sub-district government in maintaining order and security represented by the Paraja Civil Police Unit, the National Police of the Republic of Indonesia (POLRI) and the Military Rayon Command is a problem related to the aspect of shortage in the number of human resources (HR) or the number of facilities and infrastructure needed to provide services to the community.

Based on various problems faced by the Banyuputih District Government of Situbondo Regency in overcoming security and social order problems in its area, various efforts made include:


Socializing the Community

Socialization is carried out by the District Government together with related institutions such as the Police and the Military Rayon Command through Bhabinkamtibmas. The socialization process carried out by Bhabinkamtibmas, of course, is a separate attention that can support the optimization of Bhabinkamtibmas' duties in its duty area

Coordinating

Coordinating with the Regency Government and the Village Government of the District area, coordination is carried out based on the direction of the Regency Government through the District Head of Trantib which is a village apparatus that has duties and functions for the implementation of peace and public order. Coordinating with the police and the Military Rayon Command. Each head of bhabinkamtibmas in the sub-district implements the Commander Wish program, which is to carry out morning knot activities, create conditions (cipkon) and gather sub-district community leaders to discuss security and public order.

5. CONCLUSION

Based on the results of the research on the Role of the District Government in Overcoming Social Order Disturbances in Banyuputih District, Situbondo Regency, it can be concluded that the first role of the District Government is as a Regulator. As a Regulator, the sub-district government prepares directions to balance the implementation of development

(issuing regulations in the context of the effectiveness and orderliness of development administration). The sub-district government conducts Socialization Activities that are carried out when a form of decision is issued in the form of legal regulations that are regulated and intersect with public security and order. Role as Implementer, the Banyuputih District Government, Situbondo District together with several agencies such as the Pamong Praja Police Unit, Police and Koramil carry out Routine Patrols to suppress crime to maintain public order and security. As a pioneer, the sub-district government first maintains security and order in Banyuputih District, focusing on first seeking information from the potential and indications of the slightest possibility of security disturbances. This must be anticipated by the government with full sensitivity and readiness. As a Stabilizer, the role of the Banyuputih sub-district government, Situbondo Regency is to coordinate and cooperate with related agencies through BHABINKAMTIBNAS.

The obstacles experienced by the Banyuputih District Government, Situbondo Regency in overcoming disturbances of peace and order include a lack of public understanding of the law. Limited Facilities and Infrastructure and Limited Number of Personnel. Efforts made by the sub-district government include socializing related communities such as the Police and the Military Rayon Command. Coordinating with the Regency Government and the Village Government of the District area, coordination is carried out based on the direction of the Regency Government through the District Head of Trantib which is a village apparatus that has duties and functions for the implementation of peace and public order. Coordinating with the police and the Military Rayon Command.

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
